Feast of Dedication or Feast of Lights

Isaiah 34:16

“Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate (can’t

be matched or assisted): *for my mouth it hath commanded, and his spirit it hath gathered them.”* The Bible will not fail us while other books will. Flavius Josephus is an Israelite historian that at times is quoted yet we do not put our faith in his writings because Josephus fails and succumbs to traditions of men. Therefore we always advised our brothers and sisters to put their strength and energy in learning the most High’s word rather than worldly books that will lead the simple astray.

What is going to help the nation of Israel with the flood of lies? **Revelations 12:15** *“And the serpent cast out of his mouth [lies like he did with Eve] water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.”* **Verse 16:** *“And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.”* The woman (Israel) was helped not by archeology or historical books but by the Spirit that gathered his words which he commanded. **Isaiah 59:19** *“So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy [Satan through the other nations] shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.”* The standard against him is the Bible, that when is read cuts asunder the lies. Please read, **Hebrews 4:12**.

Is Josephus, Bible dictionaries, and etc the standard that an Israelite should use to defeat the enemy? Is that the standard the most High gave us? Some have stated that Josephus provides a more chronicled (in depth) point of view. Or that the Bible dictionary validates or provides evidence that what is mentioned in the scriptures is true. Today people call the feast of Dedication, the Feast of Lights. No where in the holy scriptures do we find that title. Is it a modern title given to associate a holy feast with a wicked one!

In Antiquities of the Jews by Flavius Josephus we are told that this title was being used in his time period. Josephus he states *“we celebrate this festival, and call it Lights. I suppose the reason was...”* (**Antiquities: Book: 12 Chapter: 7.7**) This was quoted

to show you that Josephus is not as “in depth”, for he did not know why the feast was called “Lights”. As we continue to examine the scriptures you will see that the Feast of Dedication shouldn’t be called so. Also that the Feast of Lights it is a Jewish Fable and it is turning you away from the commandments of the most High. Within the same book of the Josephus we read how the Edomites were converted and started calling themselves Jews. (**Antiquities: Book: 13 Chapter: 9.1**)

This is from the Encyclopedia of Britannica *“Hanukka, Chanukah, or Chanukkah, also called Feast of Dedication, Feast of Lights, or Feast of the Maccabees Jewish festival that begins on Kislev 25 (in December, according to the Gregorian calendar) and is celebrated for eight days. Hanukkah reaffirms the ideals of Judaism and commemorates in particular the rededication of the Second Temple in Jerusalem by the lighting of candles on each day of the festival. Although not mentioned in the Hebrew Scriptures, Hanukkah came to be widely celebrated and remains one of the most popular Jewish religious observances....”*

The Encyclopedia begins to show us a tradition which is Jewish and not scriptural. The observance of lighting the candles one on each day. Lets continue reading to find out the history behind this observance, *“...Although the traditional practice of lighting candles at Hanukkah was not established in the books of the Maccabees, the custom most likely started relatively early. The practice is enshrined in the Talmud, which describes the miracle of the oil in the Temple. According to the Talmud, when Judas Maccabens entered the Temple, he found only a small jar of oil that had not been defiled by Antiochus. The jar contained only enough oil to burn for one day, but miraculously the oil burned for eight days until new consecrated oil could be found, establishing the precedent that the festival should last eight days. The early date for this story or at least the practice of lighting eight candles is confirmed by the debate of the 1st-century-CE scholars Hillel and Shammai. Hillel and his school taught that one candle should be lit on the first night of Hanukkah and one more each night of the festival. Shammai held that all eight candles should be lit the first night, with the number decreasing by one each night thereafter. The celebration of Hanukkah includes a variety of religious and nonreligious customs. The most important of all is the lighting of the menorah, a candelabra with eight branches plus a holder for the shamash (“servant”) candle that is used to light the other eight candles. Olive oil was traditionally used for lighting the menorah, but it was replaced by candles, which are inserted in the menorah incrementally each night of the festival from right to left but are lit from left to right. A blessing is also offered while the candles*

are lit each night. The menorah was originally kindled outside the home, but it was brought inside in ancient times to guard against offending neighbours....” The origin was of the Talmud, what other things we should note from this practice according to the Encyclopaedia: *“In countries where Christmas rituals are widespread, **some echoes of those rituals appear in Hanukkah celebrations.**”*

*“Kindling Hanukkah (also spelled Chanukah) lights is the most important Hanukkah custom. Jews light Hanukkah candles to remember the miracle of the Maccabees' victory and the miracle of the oil that burnt for eight days in the holy Temple. It is a mitzvah (**commandment from God**) that Jews "publicize the miracle" by lighting a **Hanukkah Menorah** (also called a Chanukiah) each night during the eight days of Hanukkah.”*

Unfortunately many of our brothers and sisters of the Biblical descendants of Jacob are following Talmudic traditions. The Talmud is the traditional oral writings that the Imposter Jews follow. Some traditions are established as law because of this book. The scriptures on the other hand condemns the use of such writings. **Titus 1:14** *“Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.”* Commandment of God or men? The scriptures themselves will prove that we are not to follow this custom that attempts to make our holy feast to be in comparison to Christmas. According to the law there was only one type of Menorah. Because of this wicked custom that was started AFTER Judas Maccabees and not by our fathers there has been created a new menorah called the **“Hanukkah Menorah”**. The Biblical Menorah is not of eight or nine branches as the Feast of Lights menorahs. The Image to your right shows the Menorah that was in the Temple when the Romans stole it from our people.



Please read, **Zechariah 4:2**, and **Exodus 25:37**.

Revelations 1:13 *“And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man...”*

When Judas Maccabee recovered the temple and rededicated it to the Heavenly Father what kind of lamps would he have made? Would it be according to the law?! **1st Maccabees 4:49** *“They made also new holy vessels, and into the temple **they brought the candlestick**, and the altar of burnt offerings, and of incense, and the table.”* Rather than calling the feast “Lights” we are to be observing it exactly like the feast of Tabernacles. **1st Maccabees 4:59** *“Moreover Judas and his brethren with the whole congregation of Israel ordained, that the days of the dedication of the altar should be kept in their season from year to year by the space of eight days, from the five and twentieth day of the month Casleu, with mirth and gladness.”*



2nd Maccabees 1:9 *“And now see that ye keep **the feast of tabernacles** in the month Casleu.”* **Verse 18:** *“Therefore whereas we are now purposed to keep the purification of the temple upon the five and twentieth day of the month Casleu, we thought it necessary to certify you thereof, that ye also might keep it, **as the feast of the tabernacles**, and of the fire, which was given us when Neemias offered sacrifice, after that he had builded the temple and the altar.”* See how far away the scripture is taking us from calling it the Feast of Lights. Do we call Tabernacles the Feast of Lights? Every feast we keep contains wisdom from the most High, especially the history of why we do such custom, so when our children ask us we could declare to them the work of YHWH.



2nd Maccabees 10:1 *“Now Maccabeus and his company, the Lord guiding them, recovered the temple and the city:”* **Verse 2:** *“But the altars which the heathen had built in the open street, and also the chapels, they pulled down.”* **Verse 3:** *“And having cleansed the temple they made another altar, and striking stones they took fire out of them, and offered a sacrifice after two years, and set forth incense, and lights, and shewbread.”* **Verse 4:** *“When that was done, they fell flat*

down, and besought the Lord that they might come no more into such troubles; but if they sinned any more against him, that he himself would chasten them with mercy, and that they might not be delivered unto the blasphemous and barbarous nations.” Verse 5: “Now upon the same day that the strangers profaned the temple, on the very same day it was cleansed again, even the five and twentieth day of the same month, which is Casleu.” Verse 6: “And they kept the eight days with gladness, as in the feast of the tabernacles, remembering that not long afore they had held the feast of the tabernacles, when as they wandered in the mountains and dens like beasts.” Verse 7: “Therefore they bare branches, and fair boughs, and palms also, and sang psalms unto him that had given them good success in cleansing his place.” Verse 8: “They ordained also by a common statute and decree, That every year those days should be kept of the whole nation of the Jews.”

Israel lets teach our children to honor this day as WAS commanded. The first and LAST day is a Sabbath. Dwell in Tents as you did in Tabernacles. Repent and honor YHWH, for blessed is he who puts his trust in him and curse is the man that trust in man. Remember that Christ announced to us that there were Jews which are NOT; this is why Paul also had to write not to follow Jewish fables. The Dragon (Edomites) that calls himself Jewish does not dictate our history. YOU RUDDY LIAR

In the days of Christ he put forth parables to the people. Knowing that some were not sincere in learning wisdom, also they were not capable to comprehend his words, lest they should repent! In like fashion we are accustomed to wicked scorners that attempt to deceive and lay a snare (trap) by bearing false witness. **Mark 4:14** “*The sower soweth the word.*” **Verse 15:** “*And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.*” While they openly make their false statements and claims such as calling us the “12tribes of hate” we do not write for their sake but for those of the good and godly seed (Israel). Read, **Wisdom of Solomon 12:10-11**. Again I must help you understand what the purpose of this report is. It is to help those that are weak (of the Israelite nation) in faith that *the word that was sown in their hearts* is not taken away.

Here are a few reasons why we do not waste our time neither should you in addressing any scorners. **Matthews 7:6** “*Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.*” Which one of you will give precious jewelry such as pearls to swine (pigs)? It would be foolish seeing they have no dignity within themselves to continue in cleanliness. **2nd Peters 2:22** “*...The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow (swine) that was washed to her wallowing in the (mud) mire.*” Dogs do not have the ability to value that which is holy that’s why they enjoy their vomit.

As sincere believers do you expect any less than to be evil spoken of? It is a blessing when we are reproached for this truth sake. **2nd Corinthians 6:3** “*Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed:*” **Verse 4:** “*But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God,..*” **Verse 8:** “*By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet true;*” **Verse 9:** “*As unknown, and yet well known;...*”

The creation of this section (Dabar) of the newsletter was explained thoroughly in a few paragraphs in previous issues. One thing we failed to express is, that the language of our forefathers, Hebrew; without any Spiritual guidance is complex enough for many not to comprehend it. **1st Corinthians 12:8** *“For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;”* **Verse 10:** *“To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers (various) kinds of tongues (languages); to another the interpretation of tongues:”* It is a gift from the Heavenly Father for a man to be able to speak multiple languages for the sake of teaching his people. Do all have this gift from the Holy Spirit? **1st Corinthians 12:30** *“Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret?”* The answer is obviously, NO! Although a man has studied in college multiple languages if he is not given the Spirit of the Heavenly Father then what good is it if he speaks various languages? Notice that Paul also asked *“do all interpret?”* Because you might be able to speak or know a word in another language, but the interpretation (the use of that word) or definition according to God has not be revealed to you.

1st Corinthians 14:6 *“Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues (languages), what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?”* **Verse 9:** *“So likewise ye, except ye utter by the tongue words easy to be understood, how shall it be known what is spoken? for ye shall speak into the air.”* This is another reason why you should not take heed to those which do not know what they affirm. For as Christ hid his words to the people in wickedness, likewise the Father does not reveal his mysteries but blind their eyes that they may fall. **1st Corinthians 2:11** *“For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? [man only understands/knows what man has told him] even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.”* Yes you could pick up a dictionary, Hebrew/Greek lexicon yet you will only know *the things of a man.*

1st Corinthians 2:12 *“Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.”* Meaning the understanding we receive comes from the Spirit and mind of the Heavenly Father. We are reminded in the Bible that our ways are not his ways neither our thoughts his. The world teaches evolution, man coming from apes but the Bible teaches creation. This one of the many examples of what the spirit of the world (Satan) teaches in contrast to what Holy Spirit of God reveals freely to us.

1st Corinthians 2:13: *“Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth (Lexicons, Bible Dictionaries, Josephus, or any other books), but which the Holy Ghost (Spirit) teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.”* **Verse 14:**

“But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.”

The definitions provided in the Dabar section is not according to the natural (*man’s wisdom*) but from that which comes from above. Therefore it is easily entreated of those that are exercised in wisdom because it is without hypocrisy. There are many that are interested in learning Hebrew but as the scriptures above testified it is a gift the Heavenly Father. Therefore if you covet this gift first learn the principles (repentance, keeping the commandments, judgment, faith, etc.) of the oracles (doctrines) of God. What good is it if you know Hebrew and your prayers are not heard by God?

But unto the rest we say **Psalms 69:22** *“Let their table become a snare before them: and that which should have been for their welfare, let it become a trap.”* **Verse 23:** *“Let their eyes be darkened, that they see not; and make their loins continually to shake.”*

The table (Bible) is a trap for them, because they not sincere in learning towards the worship of the Heavenly Father. Therefore their eyes are darkened to not receive the things of God. In fact to some they count this holy wisdom to be foolishness therefore they find a way to justify their thoughts without spiritually discernment.

Similar to the English language, Hebrew words have multiple meanings. For example, the English word “fair” could mean to many things. Good as in fair weather, fair woman meaning beautiful/attractive, fair in color or light skinned in hue (color) or even a location such an exhibition for entertainment (County Fair). What about fair as impartial and just in judgment? Yet with all these and many more definitions we could determine the proper use of the word. How? By the way the word is used in the sentence. The compositions of words that precede or follow give the sense of the predicate of the indicating word. In school they called this grammar. Sometimes we were forced to explain what is a noun, verb, etc.. Yet even if you didn’t receive proper English education; you do not hear people debate the use of words. Like if I say, “I’m going to the fair” do you thinking I’m talking about being just or my complexion?

But the Bible not English is always used for such things (debate), because of upbringing and deficiency in cultural customs of the Bible. **Isaiah 28:11** *“For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people.”* Some will always attempt to drive you to a language that you might not be familiar with. Yet the Heavenly Father provided for us to learn his words in another tongue (language). Meaning that Hebrew was the language wherein the scriptures were written. But now some of our people no longer speak or understand Hebrew therefore in *another tongue* such as English, Spanish, etc. YHWH speaks to them by his Spirit.

Once more, Hebrew is a very poetic language and complex in its writing. Initially it should be treated like any other language, where there's no debate in the definitions of words. As it was clarified previously Hebrew is no measly/simple language. Hence you will discover that this language that was once lost and still is (to many) cannot be perceived only by the means of a lexicon. Based upon the whole volume of the scriptures it is easy to prove that the ancient Israelites (as they are now today) are people of a dark race (color).

The well versed Biblical and Historical scholars know this, but they will not reveal this straightforwardly to you. They attempt to hide this fact by providing what they claim "better" or more "accurate" translations of the Bible. I hope you all understand that those so called easy to read Bibles (New King James Version, NIV, etc..) are not translations directly from the Hebrew or Greek. Instead they are interpretations therefore providing their own explanations of what they think the Bible is saying.

An example of what we are referring to is given in **The Compact Bible Dictionary by Zondervan** in page 510 under Ruddy: "*a word used to refer to a red or fair complexion, in contrast to the dark skin of the Hebrews.*" They admit that the Hebrew Israelites have dark skin but yet they attempt to deceive the reader into thinking that the word ruddy is always in reference to "*red or fair complexion*". A scornor who hates the word will claim that David who was called ruddy and Esau (Edom) had the same physical appearance. **1st Samuels 16:12** "*And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he.*"

Or as some of new translations will tell you "red faced" or "red hair" with a description about his eyes (being light or sparkling). Did I miss something? Did the scripture give any description as in hair and eyes? There was only one modern interpretation Bible that gave the correct definition which was healthy. But I will not promote that Bible because the rest of the scriptures concerning the color of our people they omit! Can we prove that the word ruddy means to be of a healthy appearance? **Oxford Dictionary** states for ruddy: "*of a person or complexion freshly or healthily red. Of health youth, marked by this as an adjective of being rosy.*"

Holman's Illustrated Bible Dictionary states under ruddy: "*having a healthy, reddish color.*" Let see what the Spirit of the Lord says about this word Ruddy. **Lamentations 4:7** "*Her Nazarites [Israelites that took the vow of a Nazarite, read Numbers chapter 6] WERE (past tense) purer than snow, they WERE whiter than milk [they obeyed God's laws therefore they had no blemish, read Isaiah 1:18-19], they WERE more*

ruddy in body than rubies, their polishing was of sapphire:” These Israelites in the past were in righteousness and God blessed them physically to be healthy (*ruddy in body*). Also they were precious like *rubies*. Their elegance shined (*polishing*) like a *sapphire*. Is this saying that the Israelites were white and red as far as skin color? During the time period when Jeremiah wrote the book of Lamentations (sorrows) the Babylonians took the Israelites captive (slavery) because of their sins. Many calamities (disaster) befell them and they were cursed.



Sapphire

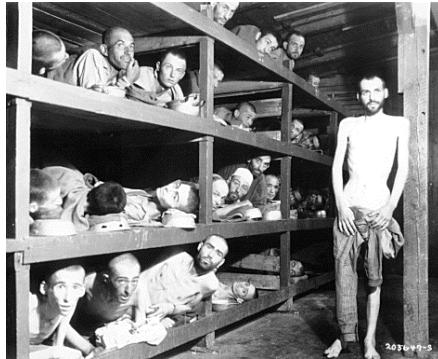


Lamentations 4:7 “Her Nazarites were purer than snow, they were whiter than milk, they were more ruddy in body than rubies, their polishing was of sapphire:” **Verse 8:** “Their visage is **blacker than a coal**; they are not known in the streets: their skin cleaveth to their bones; it is withered, it is become like a stick.” How is it that they went from white to black? Obviously the whiteness was their purity in keeping the laws. They went from being ruddy (healthy) to their bones stick out . A Mormon would tell you that black skin color is a curse from God. The Bible says contrary to that that white skin with reddish color is the curse of leprosy. **Leviticus 13:13** “Then the priest shall consider: and, behold, if the leprosy have covered all his flesh, he shall pronounce him clean that hath the plague: **it is all turned white**: he is clean.” **Verse 24:** “Or if there be any flesh, in the skin whereof there is a hot burning, and the quick flesh that burneth have a white bright spot, **somewhat reddish, or white;**” **Verse 25:** “Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, if the hair in the bright spot be turned white, and it be in sight deeper than the skin; it is a leprosy broken out of the burning: wherefore the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it is the plague of leprosy.”

This is clearly showing us that prior to becoming *withered* with famine the Nazarites were not literally physically white or red. Instead they were healthy dark skinned brothers. **Lamentations 4:7** “*Her Nazarites were purer than snow, they were whiter than milk, they were more ruddy in body than rubies, their polishing was of sapphire:*” **Verse 8:** “*Their visage is blacker than a coal; they are not known in the streets: their skin cleaveth to their bones; it is withered, it is become like a stick.*” That have become *blacker than a coal* and they are no longer healthy but skinny *like a stick*. One point that I always love to bring out is that if you look at the Fake Jews during the so called Holocaust in the pictures you will notice that they didn’t turn *blacker* but pale.



Whereas our people skin would not look rosy and healthy any more but ashy and black like the Africans in famine. **Lamentations 5:10** “*Our skin was black like an oven because of the terrible famine.*” There you go, the before and after. The Bible is not a worldly book that contradicts itself; only unbelievers attempt to misuse the scriptures in that fashion. Doesn’t the verse or chapter prove the contradiction that is caused by those that claim that men of Color like David and Adam were reddish white like Esau? Remember a Nazarite is not a tribe of the nation Israel, it was a class of men and women that were chosen or choose to put themselves into a vow with God. The dictionary and scriptures told us that Hebrew Israelites are dark skinned. Are we to believe that when they took the vow their skin color change? As you can see the claims of those that say the word *ruddy* could only have one definition has collapsed by the power of the word of God!





1st Samuels 16:11 “*And Samuel said unto Jesse, Are here all thy children? And he said, There remaineth yet the youngest, and, behold, he keepeth the sheep. And Samuel said unto Jesse, Send and fetch him: for we will not sit down till he come hither.*” **Verse 12:** “*And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was **ruddy**, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he.*” At no point did the scripture attempt to explain David’s skin color. What we could note is that it was reiterating that David was young, healthy and handsome.

1st Samuels 17:42 “*And when the Philistine looked about, and saw David, he disdained him: for he was but a youth, and ruddy, and of a fair countenance.*” The appearance of David was not that he was red, but that he was young, also handsome in the face. The Hebrew word that is used for ruddy is **אָדָמֹנִי** pronounced in the Modern Hebrew as Admowniy according to Strong’s Hebrew Lexicon number 132.

The definition it provides states from 119; reddish... The lexicon its telling us that the word derives from the definition provided in 119, let’s see what it says there. **אָדָמֹנִי** in the modern Hebrew adam; to show blood in the face, i.e., flush or turn rosy – be dyed or made...

Let’s entertain ourselves and see what Rosy means in the **Oxford Dictionary**: “*colored like a pink or red rose; especially of the complexion as indicating good health, or a blush...*” Noticed that everywhere we have read that it’s about health and not complexion. Here is where many stumble and fall because now they assume that Adam the first formed father was not of dark complexion but red (white). First the word adam has multiple meanings, sometimes in the bible it means MAN not ruddy. In fact it is used that way (as man) over five hundred times. What does Adam name mean according to the Bible? **Genesis 2:7** “*And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.*” The name Adam also means to come from the soil/earth/ground. Was it red earth that Adam was made from and maybe that’s why red is associated with his name?

Jeremiah 14:2 “*Judah mourneth, and the gates thereof languish; they are **black unto the ground**; and the cry of Jerusalem is gone up.*” Although Adam was not from the Tribe of Judah, they are his descendants. According to the Bible Adam would have

been **black unto the ground** /soil. One man that was definitely from this tribe (Judah) was King David, guess how he would have looked? Remember he had a famous son that wrote many books of wisdom; his name is Solomon. **1st Kings 4:30** “*And Solomon’s wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.*” **Verse 31:** “*For he was wiser than all men; than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: and his fame was in all nations round about.*” **Verse 32:** “*And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five.*”

Solomon wrote a book called the Songs of Solomon in which he describes himself as being black but comely (handsome). **Songs of Solomon 1:1** “*The song of songs, which is Solomon’s.* (meaning Solomon wrote it)” **Verse 5:** “*I am black, but comely, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, as the tents of Kedar, as the curtains of Solomon.*” **Verse 6:** “*Look not upon me, because I am black, because the sun hath looked upon me: my mother’s children were angry with me; they made me the keeper of the vineyards; but mine own vineyard have I not kept.*”

Some question whether this book was indeed written by Solomon and reference that the word for black in the Hebrew is in a female tense. Yet they overlook the whole text of this poetic book. **Songs of Solomon 5:10** “*My beloved is white and ruddy, the chiefest among ten thousand.*” **Verse 11:** “*HIS head is as the most fine gold, his locks are bushy, and black as a raven.*” Although Solomon wrote of himself being black and his skin somewhat burnt by the sun, a few chapters later he refers himself to being white and ruddy. Did it not say “**HIS**”? Again here the scriptures show us the proper meaning of ruddy (healthy) in relation to a person that is black. **Songs of Solomon 6:8** “*There are threescore queens, and fourscore concubines, and virgins without number.*” Solomon the beloved of many women (his wives) was pure (*white*) and blessed with beautiful health and youth (*ruddy*) to be able to possess so many wives.

The reason word adam/ אָדָם is associated with redness is because we possess something that was in Adam that shows health/life. **Acts 17:26** “*And hath made of one blood* (of Adam) *all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation;*” Blood is what cause the name of Adam to be associated with redness. When a healthy dark skin



child is playing hard and running for a long time their cheeks show some redness this is how David was perceived to be healthy. In ancient times as today, women put makeup to be perceived as healthy and beautiful. Such as blush which is for redness in the cheeks. The Hebrew word for blood is dam/ דָּם. The book of Nahum expresses the word adam as in the fashion of blood. **Nahum 2:3** “*The shield of his mighty men is **made red**, the valiant men are in scarlet: the chariots shall be with flaming torches in the day of his preparation, and the fir trees shall be terribly shaken.*” It should be obvious that word red in that verse is referring to Blood. If you don’t believe us look it up.

Apocrypha Esther 15:5 “*And she was ruddy through the perfection of her beauty, and her countenance was cheerful and very amiable: but her heart was in anguish for fear.*”

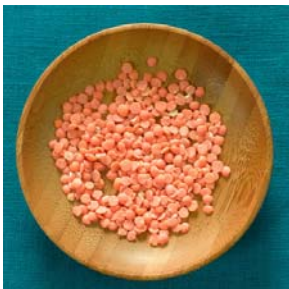
Queen Esther was a woman chosen to be queen over a strange nation because of her beauty. She hid her nationality and race. Please read, **Esther 2:10**. Showing us that nationality and race was not easily determined by appearance. For there are many dark nations in this earth and our people range from many shades of brown. Yet the scriptures say that she was ruddy if this meant to be white then the king wouldn’t have no need for her to reveal her identity to save her people. Therefore in relation to word אֲדָמוּנִי Admowniy in the modern Hebrew pertaining to Edom let’s read what it says in Genesis.



Genesis 25:30 “*And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same **red pottage**; for I am faint: therefore was his name called **Edom**.*” The reason Edom was given his name was because his appearance was because of his redness in skin color.

Genesis 25:25 “*And the first **came out red**, all over like an hairy garment; and they called his name Esau.*” Esau’s was like that red pottage, therefore not being ruddy but red. Note how the Biblical Scholars go through great lengths to make a distinction be-

tween the name Adam and Edom! For if it meant all the time to be the same thing he should have been named Adam. Here is an example of some of the red lentils.

Therefore you could not mistake the redness of an Edomite with that of an Israelite. Before we end this report, we want to point out that the word red was used a few times in reference to a red horse or heifer (cow). Please read, **Zechariah 6:2**. Horses which we are all familiar with always when referred to being red actually have the appearance of reddish-brown.



So again the appearance of the children of Israel is in comparison to the Egyptians which at times depicted themselves in this ruddy (reddish-brown) look. Like the red beans shown in here.



We give all praise and Honor to the Heavenly Father through his Son for blessing us freely with his Spirit to teach his people the heavenly wisdom. Shalam!





Genesis 9:26 “And he said, *Blessed be the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.*” **Verse 27:** “*God shall enlarge Japheth, and he shall dwell in the tents of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.*”

From the previous newsletter you were able to see the how God enlarged Japheth by providing him with great lands. Was not his dwelling in Euro-Asia? Why then many think that he was going to *dwell in the tents of Shem*? Before we begin to explain who exactly was in the tents of Shem, let’s examine **verse 26**.

Genesis 9:26 “And he said, *Blessed be the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.*” Noah is revealing the future to his sons, by the Spirit of God in the gift of prophecy. By his statement, it was revealed the chosen son in whom *the LORD God* would belong to (he is *of Shem*). **Psalms 33:12** “*Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD: and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance.*” Out of the posterity/descendants of Shem was the Lord going to choose his nation. **1st Chronicles 1:24** “*Shem (begat), Arphaxad (begat), Shelah (begat),*” **Verse 25:** “*Eber (begat), Peleg (begat), Reu (begat),*” **Verse 26:** “*Serug (begat), Nahor (begat), Terah (begat),*” **Verse 27:** “*Abram; the same is Abraham.*” **Verse 34:** “*And Abraham begat Isaac. The sons of Isaac; Esau and Israel.*” This genealogy provides us with the fulfillment of Noah’s words unto Shem. For the LORD God (YHWH) became the God of the descendants of Shem whom he chose; **Luke 1:68** “*Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,*”

As Moses also said; **Deuteronomy 4:37** “*And because he loved thy fathers, therefore he chose their seed after them, and brought thee out in his sight with his mighty power out of Egypt;*” Therefore the land of Canaan became the possession of the Israelites which are descendants of Shem (**Deuteronomy 32:49**). In so much that God promised to the descendants of Shem that the Canaanites were going to be his slaves. This prophecy was fulfilled in the days of Joshua, when he possessed much of the lands of the Canaanites. Please read, **Joshua chapter 9**.

Joshua 9:23 “Now therefore ye are cursed, and there shall none of you be freed from being bondmen (slaves), and hewers of wood and drawers of water for the house of my God.” **Note:** The so called white man (Edomites) indoctrinated the world in his attempt to justify enslaving the Blacks, Hispanics, and Native Americans with the curse of Ham teachings. But these people are in fact the Israelites, descendants of Shem!

Genesis 9:27 “God shall enlarge Japheth, and **he shall dwell in the tents of Shem**; and Canaan shall be his servant.” The “**he**” that was going to **dwell in the tents of Shem** was God that enlarge(d) Japheth. Keep in mind that the verse before (v26) showed us whom God had chosen; therefore he is reiterating what was said in that he will be established among them. **Numbers 24:2** “And Balaam lifted up his eyes, and he saw **Israel abiding in his tents** according to their tribes; and the spirit of God came upon him.” **Verse 3:** “And he took up his parable, and said, Balaam the son of Beor hath said, and the man whose eyes are open hath said:” **Verse 4:** “He hath said, which heard the words of God, which saw the vision of the Almighty, falling into a trance, but having his eyes open:” **Verse 5:** “How goodly are thy tents, O Jacob, and thy tabernacles (tents), O Israel!”

Numbers 5:2 “Command the children of Israel, that they put out of the camp every leper, and every one that hath an issue, and whosoever is defiled by the dead.” **Verse 3:** “Both male and female shall ye put out, without the camp shall ye put them; that they defile not their camps, in **the midst whereof I dwell**.” The Heavenly Father promised through his prophecy that he would dwell in the midst of the tents of Israel. You must understand that the Heavenly Father was not speaking of a building as some teachers think of their churches (places of meeting). But the people of Israel is the place in which he dwells. The spirit of God dwells in us, this is why he commands us to be holy and abstain from anything that could defile us. Please read, **1st Corinthians 3:16-17** and **Wisdom of Solomon 1:3-6**.

1st Chronicles 17:4 “Go and tell David my servant, Thus saith the LORD, Thou shalt not build me an house to dwell in:” **Verse 5:** “For I have not dwelt in an house since the day that I brought up Israel unto this day; but have gone from tent to tent, and from one tabernacle to another.” **Verse 6:** “Wheresoever I have walked with all Israel,…” Many churches, congregations, and schools believe that their location is the place in which God dwells. That high minded way of thinking shows that they are separated from God and he doesn’t dwell with them. As in the days when the tabernacle (**Exodus 40:1-9**) was taken away from the midst of Israel; **Psalms 78:59** “When God heard this, he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel.” **Verse 60:** “So that he forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent which he placed among men;”

We suffered slavery not as the Canaanites to be cursed as slaves, but to be reminded of the laws of the Heavenly Fathers (**Deuteronomy chapter 28**). **Jeremiah 10:16** “*The portion of Jacob is not like them: for he is the former of all things; and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: The LORD of hosts is his name.*” **Verse 20:** “*My tabernacle is spoiled [ruined by robbery/destruction], and all my cords are broken: my children are gone forth of me, and they are not: there is none to stretch forth my tent any more, and to set up my curtains.*” The Lord did not choose any other nation to replace the Israelites since he said, *there is none to stretch forth my tent any more.* **Jeremiah 10:21:** “*For the pastors are become brutish [dumb/stupid], and have not sought the LORD: therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered.*” Our portion is not like the other nations; we have been punished/chastised like children by a loving Father that is seeking our love. This is why we are *scattered* and do *not prosper*, because we have *not sought* (seek) *the LORD*.

Whereas Canaan was plainly cursed, and Japheth that dwells in the isles the Lord said; **Genesis 10:2** “*The sons of Japheth;...*” **Verse 5:** “*By these were **the isles** of the Gentiles divided in their lands; every one after his tongue, after their families, **in their nations.***”

Isaiah 40:13 “*Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or being his counsellor hath taught him?*” **Verse 14:** “*With whom took he counsel, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding?*” Not one of us could claim to have given God advice or directed him into the way of knowledge. Therefore we cannot question his thoughts and ways. **Isaiah 40:15** “*Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket [for a man that is thirsty a drop in a bucket is not sufficient to quench your thirst, therefore this amount is insignificant], and are counted as the small dust of the balance [a small dust in the balance will not make a difference on the scales]: behold, he taketh up **the isles** (Japheth) as a very little thing.*” **Verse 16:** “*And Lebanon [a city known for its cedars/trees] is not sufficient to burn [Lebanon provided trees in the thousands for cities to be built, but God said it does not have enough trees to be burned], nor the beasts thereof sufficient for a burnt offering [God is explaining that Japheth and the rest of the other nations cannot give enough sacrifices to become anything (accepted) before him].*” **Verse 17:** “***All nations** [except Israel] **before him are as nothing**; and they are counted to him **less than nothing**, and vanity.*”

In his infinite wisdom the Lord God considered *the isles* (Japheth) to be *less than nothing*, hence why instructed the Israelites not to intermarry with any of the other nations (*All nations*). Read, **Deuteronomy 7:1-6**. This is one of the many vanities that the brutish pastor has warranted alright to do in Christ. Citing scriptures without under-

standing of what was said aforetime for our learning and comfort. For God said not to bring them into his tabernacles because he doesn't dwell in them. **Numbers 25:6** "And, behold, one of the children of Israel came and brought unto his brethren a Midianitish woman in the sight of Moses, and in the sight of all the congregation of the children of Israel, who were weeping before the door of the tabernacle of the congregation." **Verse 7:** "And when Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, saw it, he rose up from among the congregation, and took a javelin in his hand;" **Verse 8:** "And he went after the man of Israel **into the tent, and thrust both of them through**, the man of Israel, and the woman through her belly. So the plague was stayed from the children of Israel."

Yet as for Israel he said; **Ezekiel 43:7** "And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where **I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever**, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by **their whoredom** [dealing with the other nations], nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places." **Tobit 4:12** "**Beware of all whoredom**, my son, and chiefly take a wife of the seed of thy fathers, and take not a strange woman to wife, which is not of thy father's tribe: for we are the children of the prophets, Noe, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: remember, my son, that our fathers **from the beginning, even that they all married wives of their own kindred** (people/family), and were blessed in their children, and their seed shall inherit the land (the kingdom)."

What about Japheth and any of the other nations will they be included in the tents of Shem (Jacob)? **Daniel 2:44** "And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be **left to other people** [meaning the kingdom and all its glory is for the house of Israel], but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms [as Javan that enslaved us, and the Medes that possessed us also], and it shall **stand for ever**." Do you see how great a blessing it is to be a descendant of the nation of Israel and to understand for whom is salvation?

The pastor deceived our people into thinking that they were Gentiles and that we all would be united as one in the Kingdom. **Matthews 25:31** "When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:" **Verse 32:** "And before him shall be **gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another**, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:"

Thus Japheth will not be dwelling or partaking in the blessings of Shem.

Jeremiah 30:16 "Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured [all nations will be broken in pieces by Christ]; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey." The Bible contains the full history of the Israelites. Within this book

we could read of all the captivities that the children of Israel suffered under different nations. As it was mentioned previously the sons of Japheth were involved in selling us because they were merchants of the sea. **Ezekiel 27:12** “*Tarshish was thy merchant by reason of the multitude of all kind of riches; with silver, iron, tin, and lead, they traded in thy fairs.*” **Verse 13:** “*Javan, Tubal, and Meshech, they were thy merchants: **they traded the persons of men and vessels of brass in thy market.***”

Jeremiah 30:17 “*For I will restore health unto thee (Israel), and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast [they call us now and in the past Gentiles and by proverbs such as false nationalities also by insults such as nigger, spic, etc..], saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeketh after [no nation desires for us to be restored as one people, read **Zephaniah 2:1**].*” **Verse 18:** “*Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will bring again the captivity of **Jacob's tents**, and have mercy on his dwellingplaces; and the city shall be builded upon her own heap, and the palace shall remain after the manner thereof.*” **Verse 19:** “*And out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make merry: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.*” **Verse 20:** “*Their children also shall be as aforetime, and **their congregation shall be established before me** [there is only one congregation the Lord is dealing with that is Israel, therefore our people should not be part of any other congregations such as Catholics, Baptist, Jehovah Witnesses, etc..], and I will punish all that oppress them.” **Verse 21:** “*And their nobles shall be of themselves [all this will be done in the kingdom; today our people look at the politics of the other nations and their leaders as the way of their salvation], and their governor shall proceed from the midst of them [but God said that our leaders and governors will not be into politics but will teach us to be that nation/congregation that we were once before]; and I will cause him to draw near, and he shall approach unto me: for who is this that engaged his heart to approach unto me? saith the LORD.*” **Verse 22:** “***And ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.***” **Verse 23:** “*Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goeth forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked [the God of Israel is punishing many nations for their oppression and wickedness to his people].*” **Verse 24:** “*The fierce anger of the LORD shall not return [they will not stop sufferings], until he have done it [until he cause our people to consider their ways], and until he have performed the intents of his heart: in the **latter days** [in the last days] **ye shall consider it.***” Shalam!*
